



Male Rhinoplasty (Nose Surgery) FAQ's

Q: Is it possible to straighten my badly bent nose?

A: In most instances the answer is yes. Dr McGovern can definitely improve the angle of your nose, but you may be left with a slight bend after surgery.

Q: What is the cost of Rhinoplasty?

A: This will depend on the extent of your surgery. If you have broken your nose in the past, or have had breathing problems because the airway is crooked, Medicare will cover some of your costs. Our staff can help you with costs relevant to your particular situation at consultation. We offer a free consultation with our registered nurses to facilitate this.

Q: I have broken my nose and it is crooked, what happens now?

A: A cosmetic plastic and reconstructive surgeon can fix lumps and bumps following a broken nose and help to restore your airways so that you can breathe normally again. If you have only recently broken your nose, you will need to wait until the swelling settles before we can assess the problem or perform any treatment. Generally we would wait for 3 months after the break before assessing and treating your problem.

Q: How much time will I need off work after nose surgery?

A: You will need 2 weeks off work if your job is physical, 1 week if you have an office job. We want to avoid an increase in blood pressure for 2 weeks following your surgery to avoid nose bleeds.

You will have a plaster dressing covering your nose for 5 or 6 days, and you may have some bruising which can take up to 10 days to subside.

We give you an Arnica spray prior to rhinoplasty which helps to prevent bruising. This and the use of ice packs following surgery really do reduce any bruising.
